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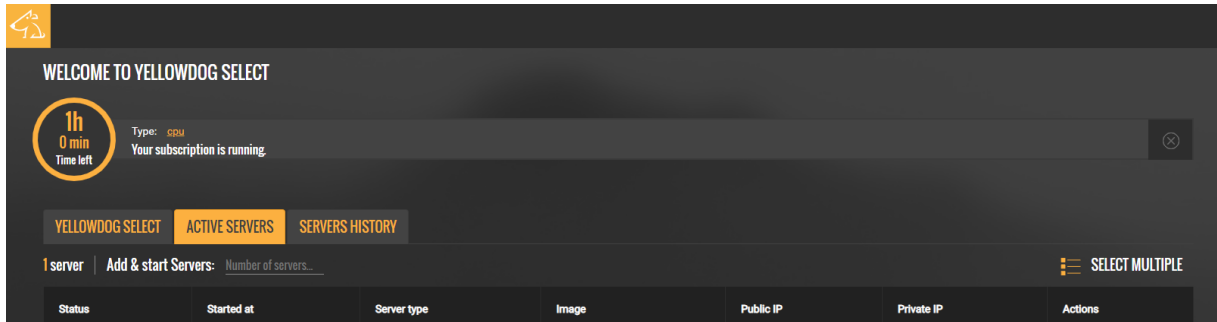
USING THE YELLOWDOG PORTAL

YellowDog can be managed using the YellowDog Portal.

To access the Portal, navigate to **<https://platform.yellowdog.co/#/login>** and login using the username and password provided by YellowDog.

VERIFYING SUBSCRIPTION SETTINGS

On logging into the Portal, you should see the following screen:

If you cannot see these tabs, or if you see unexpected additional tabs, please contact YellowDog to update your subscription settings.

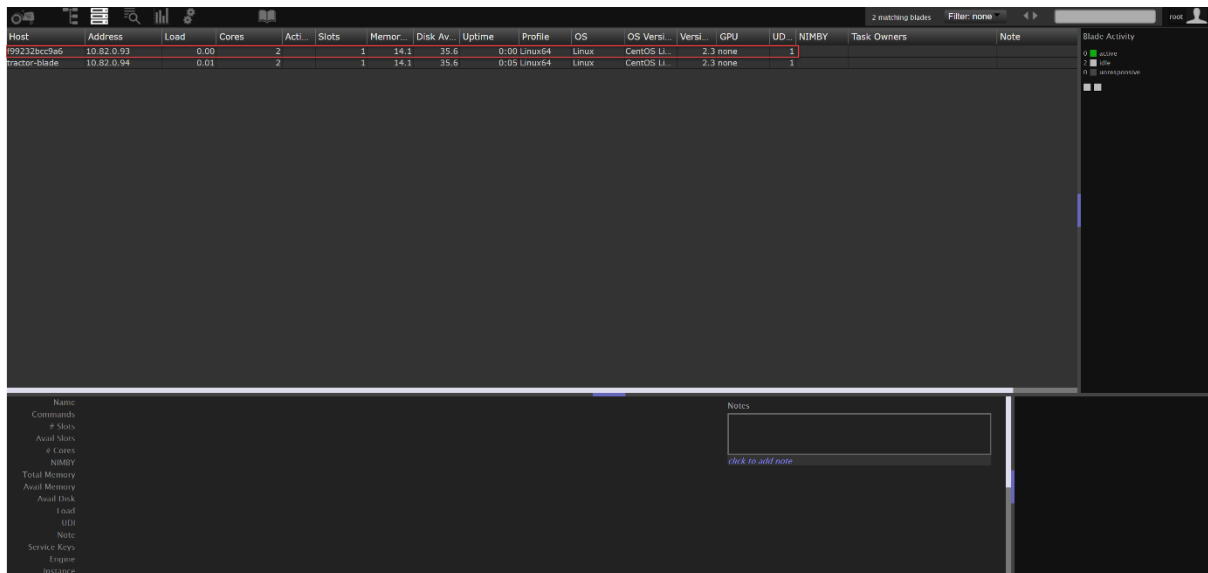
MANAGING SERVERS

ADDING AND STARTING SERVERS

Servers are automatically started when added. To add a server:

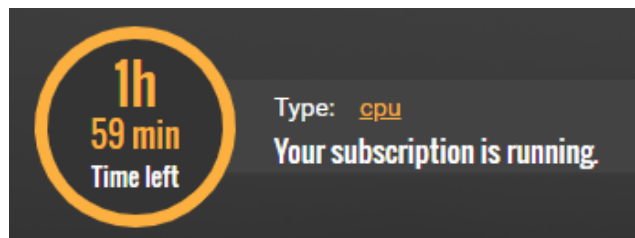
1. Click on the **Active Servers** tab.
2. Enter the number of servers to add and click **Start**.

Once servers have been started, their details can be seen within your Render Manager.

Example subscription information

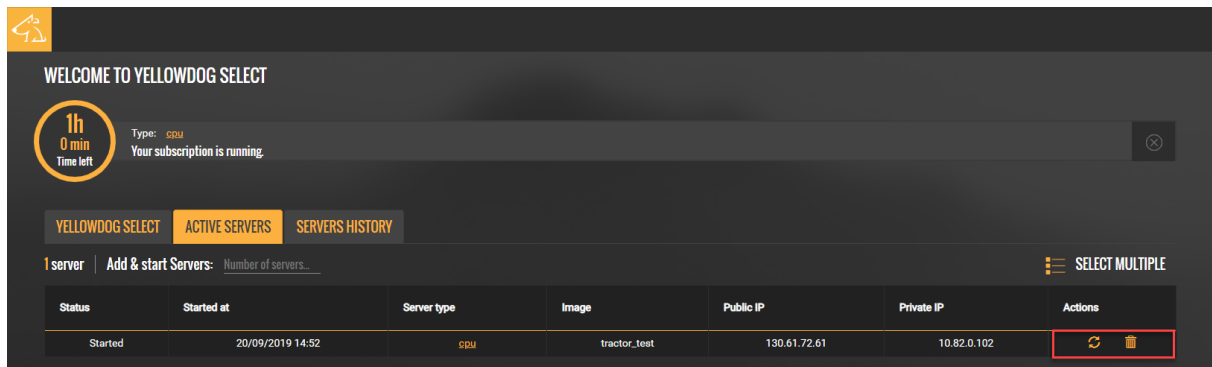
REBOOTING AND TERMINATING SERVERS

Servers can be rebooted and terminated individually or as a group.

MANAGING A SINGLE SERVER

To reboot or terminate an individual server:

1. Click on the **Active Servers** tab.
2. On the line for the relevant server, under **Actions**, click the reboot or terminate icon as appropriate.
3. Click **Yes** to confirm.

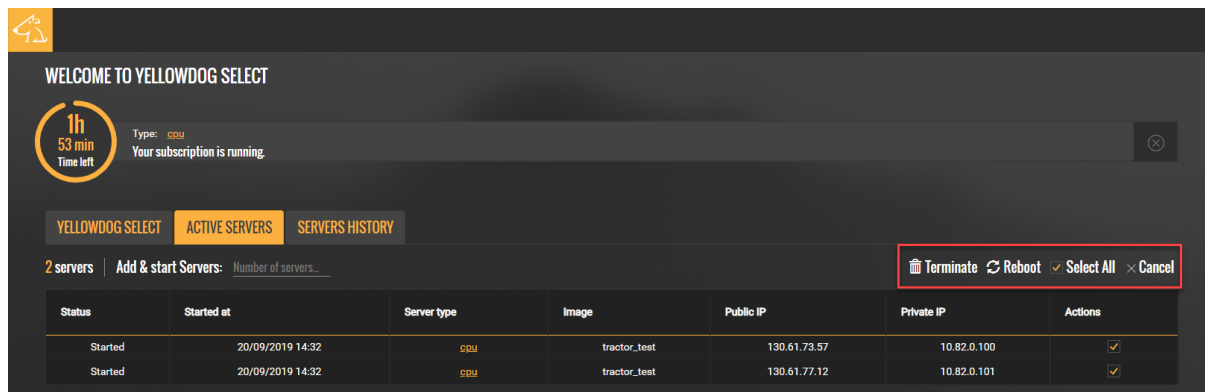


Using the Actions icons

MANAGING MULTIPLE SERVERS

To select more than one server:

1. Click on the **Active Servers** tab.
2. Click on the **Select Multiple** option. An action menu will appear.
3. Select the servers to reboot or terminate. You can use the action menu to select all servers if required
4. In the action menu, click **Terminate** or **Reboot** as appropriate.
5. Click **Yes** to confirm.




Using the action menu to manage multiple servers

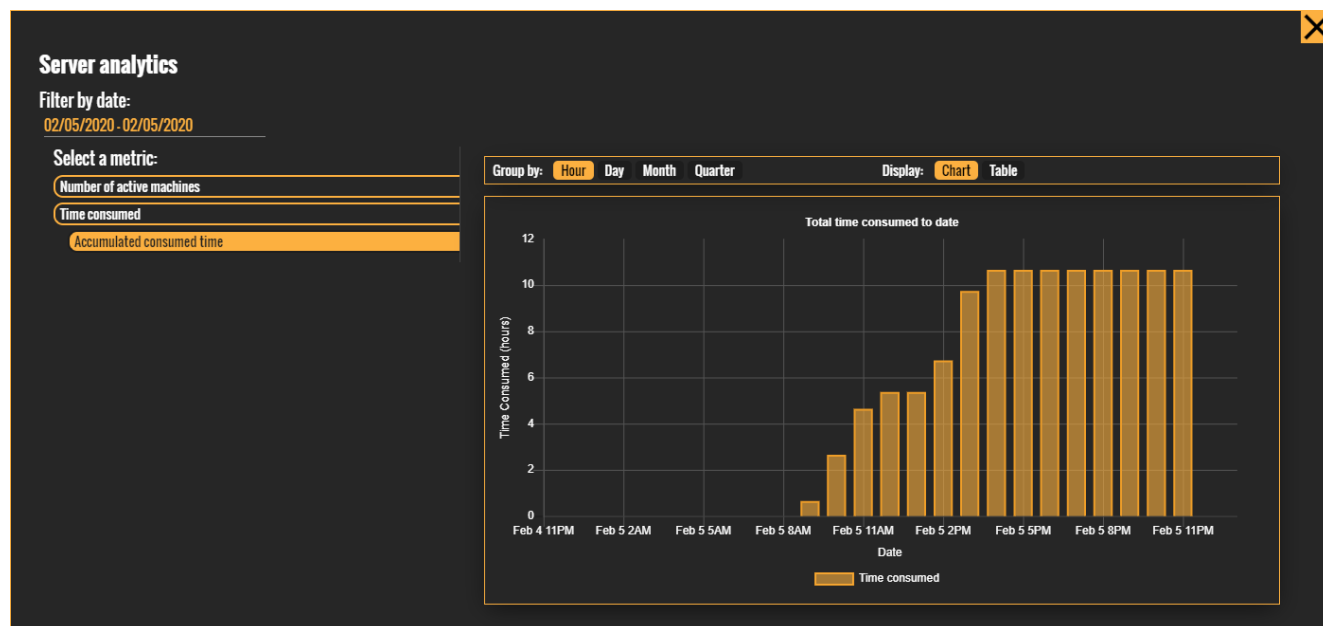
REPORTS AND ANALYTICS

USAGE

You can use the **Server analytics** page to view information such as the number of servers, or the amount of server time, that you have used in a specific time period.

To view your usage information:

1. Click the **Analytics** icon . This can be found on your user avatar menu, or on the **Active Servers** or **Servers History** tab.
2. Select the time period of interest. Click on **Filter by date** and choose the start and end dates from the calendar.
3. Click on the type of usage information you want to view:
 - a) **Number of active machines** The number of servers active during each interval (hour, day, month or quarter) of the selected time period.
 - b) **Time consumed** The server hours used during each interval of the selected time period.
 - c) **Accumulated consumed time** The total server hours used up to each interval of the selected time period.
4. Use the chart options above the chart to change the interval or the display format.

CHART OPTIONS

- **Group by** This enables you to change the size of the intervals shown within the selected time period. Data can be shown for each hour, day, month, or quarter.
- **Display** Usage can be shown as a chart (graph) or in a table.
